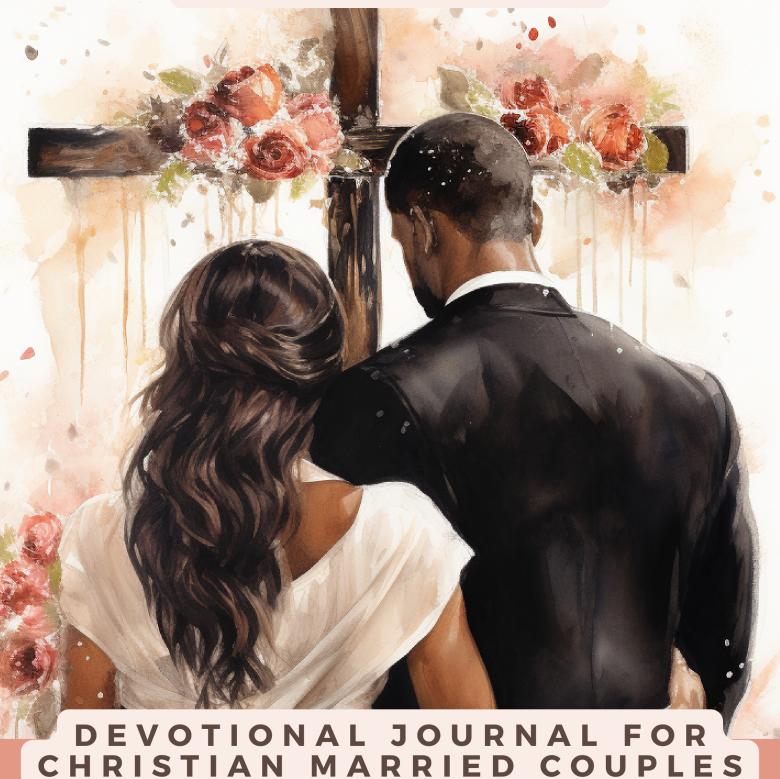

Day 1: The Foundation of Love Scripture: 1 Corinthians 13:4-7

Begin this journey by exploring the essence of love. Reflect on how you can cultivate patience, kindness, and selflessness in your marriage Make a list of all the words that describe love in 1 Corinthians 13:4-7. Look up each word and write down their meanings.



Day 2: Unity in Christ Scripture: Ephesians 4:2-3

Explore the concept of unity in Christ. Consider how you and your spouse can work together, growing in your faith and strengthening your marriage. Write down practical examples of how you can be more in unity.



Day 3: Communication Scripture: Proverbs 15:1

Why is it important to communicate? What happens in your marriage when you don't communicate? Reflect on how your words can either build or break your marriage, and seek ways to enhance your communication with your spouse. Write down ways you can improve communication with your spouse.



Day 4: Forgiveness Scripture: Colossians 3:13

There is power and freedom in forgiveness. Reflect on any past hurts and challenges, and commit to forgiving your spouse as Christ forgave you. Do you need to forgive? Do you need to ask for forgiveness? Write down something you want to share with your spouse on this topic.



Day 5: Gratitude Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 5:18

Cultivate an attitude of gratitude. Each day, express your appreciation for your spouse and the blessings within your marriage. Write down all the things you are thankful for when it comes to your spouse. Share these things with your spouse.



Day 6: Servant Leadership Scripture: Mark 10:43-45

Reflect on the concept of servant leadership. Consider how both you and your spouse can serve each other with humility, fostering a Christlike atmosphere in your marriage. Where is there a need for improvement? Write down your thoughts and feelings on this topic and share them with your spouse.



Day 7: Intimacy in Marriage Scripture: Song of Solomon 7:10

Celebrate the beauty of marital intimacy as a gift from God. Reflect on ways to enhance and deepen the physical, emotional, and spiritual connection in your marriage. How can you help strengthen and improve this area of married life? Are you holding back? Do you understand the needs and desires of your spouse?



Day 8: Patience in Adversity Scripture: James 1:2-4

Explore the role of patience during challenging times. Commit to supporting and encouraging each other, trusting that God is using difficulties to refine and strengthen your marriage. How can you handle adverse times in your marriage with more patience? How can you be more patient?



Day 9: Praying Together Scripture: Matthew 18:19-20

Discover the power of praying together. Make time each day to join in prayer, seeking God's guidance and blessings for your marriage. Write down reasons why you and your spouse should pray more often together. What are the benefits?



Day 10: Financial Stewardship Scripture: Proverbs 3:9-10

Reflect on the importance of financial stewardship in marriage. Consider how you can work together to manage resources wisely and align your financial decisions with God's principles. Do you agree on how the finances are managed? How can you come into more agreement?



Day 11: Friendship in Marriage Scripture: Proverbs 17:17

Nurture the friendship within your marriage. Reflect on the joy and
strength that comes from being friends with your spouse, and invest
time in enjoying shared activities. Sometimes life can get in the way
and you can forget how much fun you can have together. Write down
all the things you love about being friends with your spouse.



Day 12: Parenting Together Scripture: Psalm 127:3-5

Explore the responsibilities of parenting together. Reflect on how you can support each other in raising children with love, discipline, and a focus on godly values. Write down the differences you have in your parenting style and then find ways to come into agreement.



Day 13: Encouraging Spiritual Growth Scripture: Proverbs 27:17

How much do you encourage your spouse to growing spiritually? Commit to encouraging each other's spiritual growth. Reflect on how you can support your spouse's journey with God, fostering a shared commitment to growing in faith.



Day 14: Date Night Scripture: Genesis 2:24

Celebrate the bond of marriage with a special date night. Reflect on the significance of spending quality time together and strengthening your connection. What can you do so that you spend more quality time together?



Day 15: Laughter in Marriage Scripture: Proverbs 17:22

Explore the importance of laughter and joy in your marriage. Reflect on shared moments of laughter and commit to finding humor even in challenging times. Sometimes life is so busy and so....serious. What can you do to remember to laugh more together?



Day 16: Sacrificial Love Scripture: Ephesians 5:25

Reflect on the sacrificial love exemplified by Christ. Consider how you				
can demonstrate selfless love to your spouse, putting their needs above your own. Write down some ideas that come to mind about				
				how you cand demonstrate sacrificial love toward your spouse.



Day 17: Resolving Conflict Biblically Scripture: Matthew 18:15-17

Address conflict in a biblical manner. Reflect on the steps outlined in Matthew 18, and commit to resolving disagreements with love, humility, and respect. Write down things you can do to resolve conflicts in a godly way.



Day 18: Protecting Your Marriage Scripture: Proverbs 4:23

Guard your heart because everything you do flows from it. The enemy would love to get between you and your spouse and even send you to divorce court. God doesn't like and never intended divorce. So guard your marriage like you guard your heart from negative influences and from other people who try to create division. What are some ways you can protect your marriage?



Day 19: Expressing Affection Scripture: Song of Solomon 1:2

Some people naturally show more affection than others. Explore the importance of expressing affection in your marriage. Reflect on the different ways you can show love and appreciation for your spouse daily. Write down your thoughts on this and share them with your spouse.



Day 20: Rekindling Romance Scripture: Proverbs 5:18-19

Life gets busy, and sometimes it takes effort to nurture the romance in your marriage. Christ wants His bride to remember her first love. To be on fire and full of passion for Him. Likewise, we should be this way toward our spouse. Reflect on ways to keep the flame alive and continue to pursue each other with passion.



Day 21: Seeking God's Will Together Scripture: Proverbs 3:5-6

Commit to seeking God's will together. Reflect on how you can align your individual and collective aspirations with God's plan for your marriage.



Day 22: Building Trust Scripture: Proverbs 31:11

Explore the significance of trust in marriage. Reflect on ways to build and maintain trust, ensuring a strong foundation for your relationship. Write down all the ways you trust your spouse. Or if there are things that make you not trust your spouse, write those things down and discuss them. Trust is everything in a marriage so it's very important to be open and communicate.



Day 23: Respecting Differences Scripture: 1 Peter 3:7

Celebrate the uniqueness of each other. Reflect on the beauty of your differences and commit to respecting and valuing the individual qualities that make your marriage rich and diverse. Write down all the things that make your spouse different from you and celebrate them!



Day 24: Navigating Seasons of Change Scripture: Ecclesiastes 3:1-8

Acknowledge that your marriage will go through different seasons. Reflect on how you can navigate change together, trusting in God's plan for each season of your life. Write down the different seasons you've already weathered. Share your insights with your spouse.



Day 25: Hospitality and Generosity Scripture: Hebrews 13:2

Explore the practice of hospitality and generosity. Reflect on how you can open your hearts and home to others, sharing God's love as a couple. Or how can you share the wisdom God has given you in your marriage with other newly married couples? Write down all the ideas that come to mind.



Day 26: Keeping God at the Center Scripture: Colossians 3:17

Reaffirm your commitment to keep God at the center of your		
marriage. Reflect on ways to honor God in your thoughts, actions, and		
decisions as a couple. Share what you write down with your spouse.		



Day 27: Encouraging Dreams and Goals Scripture: Proverbs 16:3

Discuss and support each other's dreams and goals. Reflect on how
you can encourage and empower one another to pursue the plans
God has placed in your hearts. Write down practical ways you can
support your spouse.



Day 28: Fostering Emotional Intimacy Scripture: Proverbs 20:5

Explore the depths of emotional intimacy. How open are you with your spouse? Do you open up? Reflect on the importance of vulnerability and open communication in building a strong emotional connection. In what ways can you improve in this area?



Day 29: Renewing Commitment Scripture: Ruth 1:16-17

Renew your commitment to each other. Reflect on the loyalty and
devotion exemplified in the story of Ruth and Naomi, and recommit to
walking this journey of life together. Write down specific ways you can
recommit to your spouse.



Day 30: Celebrating Milestones Scripture: Ecclesiastes 4:9-12

Celebrate the milestones in your marriage. Reflect on the journey you've taken together and express gratitude for the love, grace, and strength that have sustained you. Commit to facing the future hand in hand, with God as your guide.
